10:30	Sustainability Minor - 19-872. A new, multi-disciplinary minor in sustainability that will involve all three colleges. Has the support of 3 Deans and multiple department chairs. Environmental Studies will be the home to this minor. The curriculum will be tended by an interdisciplinary steering committee comprised of faculty from ENST, ESM, Politics, GESA, and BA, plus a representative from the campus Sustainability Office. The minor is 18-20 units and involves roughly 25 courses across 15 departments. More specifically, courses fall into three thematic areas: 1) Earth Science, Technology & Built Environment; 2) Socio-economic Institutions, Policy, & Equity; and 3) Communication, Culture & Ethics. The proposal narratively maps out course rotations and includes MAPs for the majors most likely to use this minor (BA, ESM, ENST, PSCI, GEOG, NAS) to show how each major can easily take sufficient elective units unique to the minor (i.e., not counting towards the major). The proposal also includes a curriculum map matrix that links 4 PLOs to the 3 required courses for the minor (ENST 195, BA 106, ENST 470) and to the 3 thematic areas of elective courses.
