## Voting Action Calendar

[ENGR - 492CW - 22-1760 - New Course - Mechanical Engineering Capstone Design II](#) (3 units). This course adds a semester to the Mechanical Engineering capstone allowing the students time to prototype and implement designs. This is consistent with capstone experiences in other mechanical engineering programs and the emphasis and strength that we hope to develop in the program at Humboldt. The course is also designated as a GWAR completing course.

[FISH - 314 - 22-1753 - Course Change - Fishery Science Communication](#). This proposal designates FISH 314 as fulfilling the GWAR requirement.

[MUS - 305 - 22-1797 - Course Change - Jazz: An American Art Form](#). This proposal designates MUS 305 as fulfilling the DCG-domestic requirement (the history of jazz is largely a history of issues of discrimination in America). Additionally, the course is re-certified as UD Area C course at the same time.
