Two curriculum changes were approved for recommendation to the Senate

09-238 NRPI 460 – course title and description change; from Natural Resource Agency Planning to Environmental Planning for Public Lands - New Description: Environmental planning processes applied by state and federal agencies to manage for desired ecological, economic, and social outcomes on public lands. Key themes: collaborative processes, community involvement, stewardship.

09-241 ZOOL 476 – Principles of Animal Development

Program Planning and Assessment Subcommittee: No report

Academic Master Planning Subcommittee (Moyer)

Proposed guidelines for minors were presented. Several issues were raised regarding the particular recommendations, including the number of units required to be distinct from other courses of study (major, other minor), number of faculty to support the minor, interdisciplinary standards versus embedded minors standards, distinct and/or overlapping learning outcomes, etc.

Some issues were raised that had already been researched and discussed in AMP. It was agreed that more context should be written into the draft, including the rationale for developing the guidelines and background (including research, such as CSU comparisons).

The proposal is being returned to AMP for further development.
